




Western blot analysis of various lysates, using Anti-RIP3 Antibody (A17064) at 1:3,000 dilution. The secondary antibody was Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG H&L Antibody (HRP) at 1:10,000 dilution. Lysates/proteins were present at 25µg per lane. The blocking buffer used was 3% non-fat dry milk in TBST. Detection was with a ECL Basic Kit. Exposure time: 30s.




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

Immunohistochemistry analysis of paraffin-embedded human liver cancer using Anti-RIP3 Antibody (A17064) at a dilution of 1:100 (40x lens). Perform microwave antigen retrieval with 10 mM PBS buffer pH 7.2 before commencing with IHC staining protocol.



Immunohistochemistry analysis of paraffin-embedded mouse pancreas using Anti-RIP3 Antibody (A17064) at a dilution of 1:100 (40x lens). Perform microwave antigen retrieval with 10 mM PBS buffer pH 7.2 before commencing with IHC staining protocol.



Immunofluorescence analysis of C6 cells using Anti-RIP3 Antibody (A17064) at a dilution of 1:50 (40x lens). DAPI was used to stain the cell nuclei (blue).
