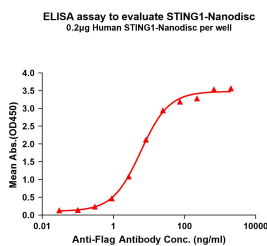


# Synthetic Nanodisc Human STING Protein (A317350)

Name:	Synthetic Nanodisc Human STING Protein
Description:	Synthetic nanodiscs offer a stable and biologically relevant environment that closely mimics cell membranes and enables full-length transmembrane human STING protein to be purified and analysed in vitro.
Expression System:	HEK293 cells

Protein Species:	Human
Protein Length:	Full length protein.
Molecular Weight:	Full length human STING protein has a MW of 42.2 kDa.
Conjugate:	Unconjugated
Product Form:	Lyophilized
Concentration:	Reconstitution dependent.
Formulation:	Lyophilized from nanodisc solubilization buffer (20mM Tris-HCl, 150mM NaCl, pH 8.0). Normally 5%-8% Trehalose is added as a protectant before lyophilization.
Storage:	Shipped at 4°C. Lyophilized: Store at -20°C to -80°C. Reconstituted: Aliquot and store at -80°C. Product is stable for one year. Avoid freeze/thaw cycles.

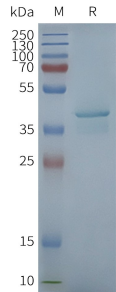
## Images:



ELISA plates were pre-coated with Synthetic Nanodisc Human STING Protein (A317350) at 0.2µg/per well. Serial diluted Anti-Flag Monoclonal Antibody solutions were added, washed, and incubated with a secondary antibody before reading the ELISA. From the above data, the EC50 for Anti-Flag Monoclonal Antibody binding with Synthetic Nanodisc Human STING Protein (A317350) is 5.896ng/ml.
