

## Anti-Vimentin Antibody [V9] (A250310)

### Specifications:

Name:	Anti-Vimentin Antibody [V9]
Description:	Mouse monoclonal [V9] antibody to Vimentin.
Specificity:	This antibody reacts with a 58kDa protein identified as vimentin. It shows no cross-reaction with other closely related intermediate filament proteins (IFP however, when used in panels with other antibodies, it is useful for the sub-classification of a given tumor. Expression of vimentin, when used in conjunction with anti-keratin, is helpful when distinguishing melanomas from undifferentiated carcinomas and large cell lymphomas. All melanomas and Schwannomas react strongly with anti-vimentin. It labels a variety of mesenchymal cells, including melanocytes, lymphocytes, endothelial cells, and fibroblasts. Non-reactivity of anti-vimentin is often considered more useful than its positive reactivity, since there are a few tumors that do not contain vimentin, e.g. hepatoma and seminoma. Anti-vimentin is also useful as a tissue process control reagent.

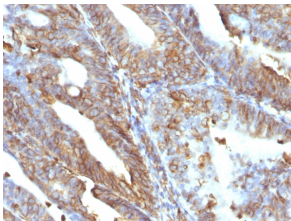

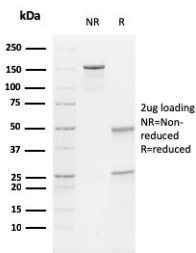

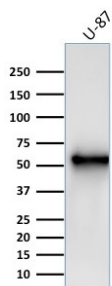

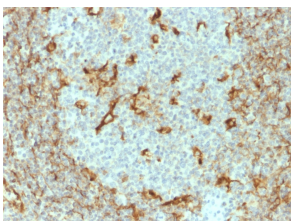
Immunohistochemical analysis of formalin-fixed, paraffin-embedded human uterine carcinoma using Anti-Vimentin Antibody [V9].
